

1. Agitate the tube to coat tube with anticoagulant


5. Attach safety needle



2. Draw blood




6. Draw up to 10mL of air



7. Pierce the safety needle into the cap and withdraw slightly


3. Gently shake immediately

after blood draw to mix well




8. Draw blood from ACD-A tube


4. Pierce blister








9. Inject blood through the blister hole


13. Secure gauze while removing the backing
